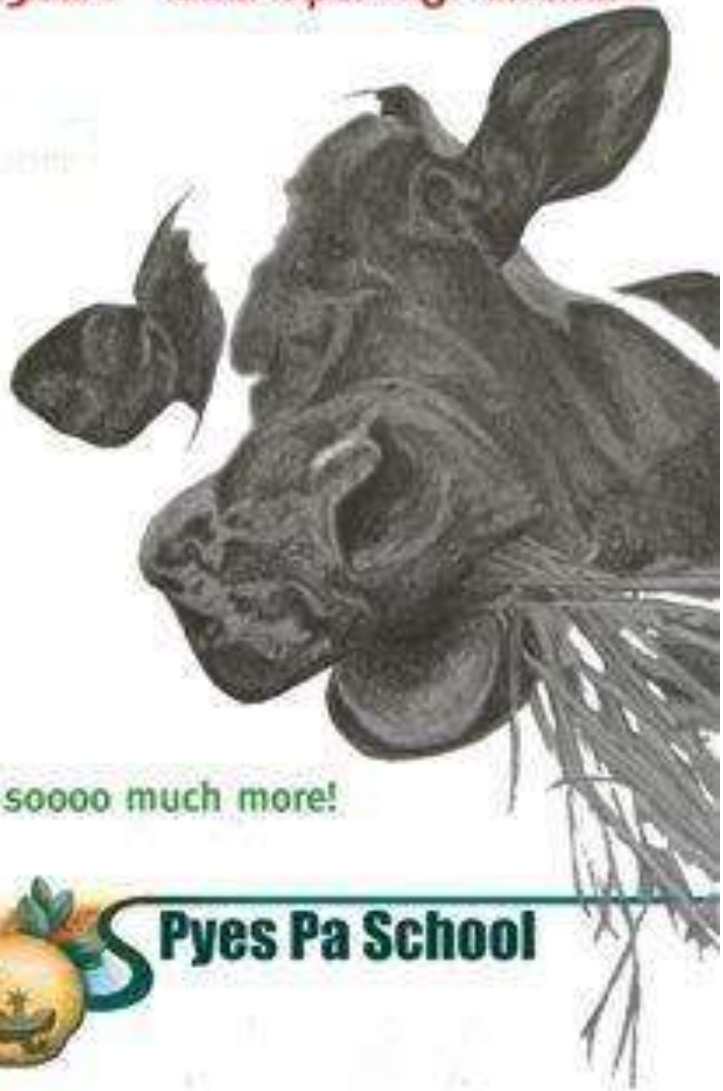

WHAT IS CALF CLUB AND GALA DAY?

This is the day where all children at Pyes Pa School have the opportunity to show off their calf, lamb, goat, chicken or caged animal in the morning and then have fun at the Gala Day from 10am until 2pm.

CALF CLUB

Judging of the animals is from 8am until 10am. The following rules and categories have been extracted straight from the Tauranga Boys and Girls Agricultural Group Day rules. It is traditional that the winners of each category can then enter their animal into the Group Day on Saturday 24 October at the Tauranga Race Course. Only one calf, lamb or goat entry per child please. **If you know of anyone that may be able to supply or be a judge for lambs/goats/calves to students, can you please give the office a call.**

Categories and Rules


Calf

Calves born on or after 20th July may be entered.

All animals to be exhibited must be hand reared, or if reared on a cow, able to be managed and have been tended to solely by the exhibitor, except for assistance in cleaning on Field Day

JUNIORS in all events are children who are under 9 years of age on July 1st.

All over this age are SENIORS.

DAIRY; Heifer calves only

DAIRY BEEF: Bull, Heifer, and Steer calves from a Dairy breed cow/ Beef breed bull, and Bull and Steer calves of Dairy breed.

BEEF: Bull, Heifer and Steer calves from a Beef breed Bull.

Crosses are to be classified according to the parent breed.

Lamb

Lambs born on or after 1st August may be entered.



All lambs to be exhibited must be hand reared and tended solely by the exhibitor except for assistance with cleaning on Field Day.

Lambs if washed will be disqualified.

Lambs should preferably have tails docked.

JUNIORS in Lamb classes are children who are under 9 years of age on July 1st. All over this age are SENIORS.

Goat

Goats born on or after 1st August may be entered.

All goats to be exhibited must be hand reared and tended solely by the exhibitor, except for assistance with cleaning on Field Day.

Chickens

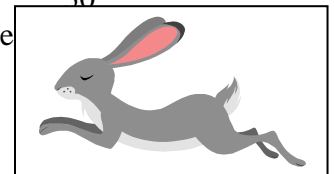
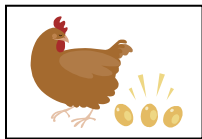
Chickens to be hatched on or after 16th July.

All poultry exhibited must be hand reared and tended solely by the exhibitor.

Only chickens ordered from the school in Term 2 can be entered into the Group Day, however for our Gala Day home hatched poultry can be entered if you wish.

JUNIORS in Poultry classes are children who are under 9 years of age on July 1st. All over this age are SENIORS.

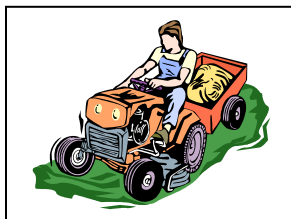

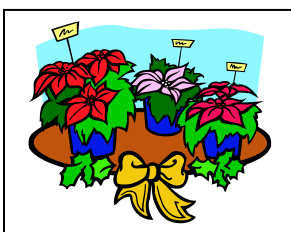
